We will bring and provide breakfast at the cabins and will provide burgers/dogs for lunch this year and not use the dining hall at all. There are no meals served Friday or Saturday night. We will have everything for s'mores too! You will need to bring whatever you would like for dinner on Saturday evening.

**About Our Campout:** This is a full service campground, meaning that you will be in cabins with heat and in some cases A/C. All cabins will have a bathrooms and showers. Most cabins have between 12 and 16 beds (6 to 8 bunk beds). The bunk-beds are hard with what resembles a mattress. Bring either blankets or a sleeping bag and pillows. There are no linens, so you need to bring towels and such. Don't forget the stuffed animals and those stinky blankets that every kid has and needs to go to sleep. With that said, make sure you have it when you leave. These are cabins, not hotel rooms so set your expectations accordingly. Please keep the kids from jumping off of the bunk beds – a broken leg or twisted wrist is not the memory you are looking to achieve.

**GOALS:** This is a great opportunity to bond with and spend time with your kids. If you spend time just chatting with other parents and working on your cellphone then your kids will notice. Take this weekend and show your kids you love having fun alongside them. Let loose and put the phones away (except to get pics of all the fun!). Make new friends but focus on the kids and make memories that neither of you will ever forget. This weekend will mean the world to them, *especially without an ipad!*

**THINK ABOUT BRINGING:** These are some things you may want to bring with you or work with other people going to ensure you're covered! Twin sized sheets and pillows and/or sleeping bags for your crew. Shower caddy & Towels. Water Bottle. Backpack. Coffee maker, press or instant! Flashlights. Card games. Drinks. Fishing rods and tackle boxes. Lawn Chairs. Sunscreen.

**FOOD:** Dinner for Friday is sometimes easiest as a fast food stop on your way out! Saturday morning we will have ice chests and boxes with food at each cabin to cook over the fire. Saturday nite you are on your own and guys tend to get creative. I've seen fajitas, sausage, steaks, and chicken cooks via the fires. Bring what you need to cook (foil, sticks, paper products) and cook with your kids and show them how to cook over the fire. It's a blast!
